

POSTGAME NOTES

CLEVELAND BROWNS VS. BUFFALO BILLS | FIRSTENERGY STADIUM | NOV. 10, 2019

- RB **Nick Chubb** led the team with 116 rushing yards. He has recorded at least 75 scrimmage yards in eight consecutive games, the longest active streak in the NFL and the longest such streak by a Brown since **Reuben Droughns** in 2005. Chubb has four 100-yard rushing games this season and nine in his career. Chubb's 919 rushing yards are the sixth-most by a Brown through the first nine games. Chubb is averaging 102.1 rushing yards per game this season.

- WR **Jarvis Landry** recorded nine receptions for 97 yards and one touchdown. Landry's 526 receptions are tied for the second-most all-time by an NFL player through their first six seasons.

- QB **Baker Mayfield** threw for 238 yards and two touchdowns. Mayfield's 5,926 career passing yards and 36 passing touchdowns are each the most by a Brown in their first two seasons. His 2,201 passing yards this season are the sixth-most by a Brown in the first nine games.

- WR **Odell Beckham Jr.** and Landry each extended their streak of consecutive games with at least two receptions. Landry's stretch of 88 consecutive games is the longest active streak in the NFL, while Beckham ranks third at 68.
